

## Connect your Windows or Mac Laptop for a Presentation in your Classroom

Your ITG supported General Purpose Classroom is equipped with a connection that allows you to show presentations on the classroom projector directly from your laptop.

In your classroom, locate the cables shown at the right. The VGA video cable is the blue connector & the Stereo Mini audio cable is the aqua connector (colors may vary, many are black) This connection is sent to the projector when iLaptop1 is selected on either the touch panel or System7 switcher. Follow the simple steps below to connect your laptop.



### Windows

For best results, make connections, then turn the laptop power ON.



Connect the VGA cable to the plug on your laptop that looks like the one above.



Connect the Stereo Mini cable to the headphone jack as shown above.



Most laptops have a key combination that will send the video out. Usually [Ctrl] + [F5] or [F8].

### Did you know?

Most projectors prefer a display resolution of 1024 X 768. If your laptop's resolution is set higher, the projector may not display the image properly. On Windows, you may change this setting in the Control Panel. On Mac, go to System Preferences.



### Mac

For best results, make connections, then turn the laptop power ON.



Your Mac will likely require an adapter, similar to the one above, to connect to the VGA cable.



Connect the Stereo Mini cable to the headphone jack as shown above.



Your laptop should automatically sense the connection and mirror the desktop on the projector
